Chacocente Christian School

Chacocente Christian School (CCS) opened in 2005, offering a tuition-free education to the children of Project Chacocente. Currently, over 150 children from the Project and the surrounding neighborhood are enrolled in pre-school through Grade 11, the final year of high school in Nicaragua.

CCS sets itself apart by offering a full day of classes, including a nutritious lunch and by smaller teacher-to-student ratios. We also offer classes that are not available in the public school system, such as English, Art, Computer Science, and Animal Husbandry. Our students routinely place high in competitions, both academic and athletic, at the local, state and national levels.

While Nicaragua has the twelfth highest primary school dropout rate in the world, CCS retains nearly 98% of students in 1st through 6th grades.
