For our friends living day-to-day in rural Nicaragua, the needs are great. We remain committed to working alongside the Chacocente community as they journey from poverty to well-being and self-sufficiency.

Please consider taking part in one or both of two fundraising activities we have planned that will enable Project Chacocente to carry its vital ministry on into the New Year:

“Steps of Hope” - Our First Ever Virtual 5K

Spend the month of November walking, running, biking, or trotting (as in Turkey Trot) as many 5Ks as you can (5 kilometers is from the main highway to the Project). To ensure the success of this event we encourage you to invite family, friends, neighbors and co-workers to sponsor you, or to participate directly themselves!

The people of the Project know that the pandemic has made life difficult for everyone and they would like to share the proceeds from this fundraiser with people in need in the United States. The proceeds you raise can be split between Project Chacocente and a local ministry of your choice. Registration is \$50 and includes a t-shirt and special photo from the Project; these items will be mailed in December.
